All Meetings are open to MCDA Members!



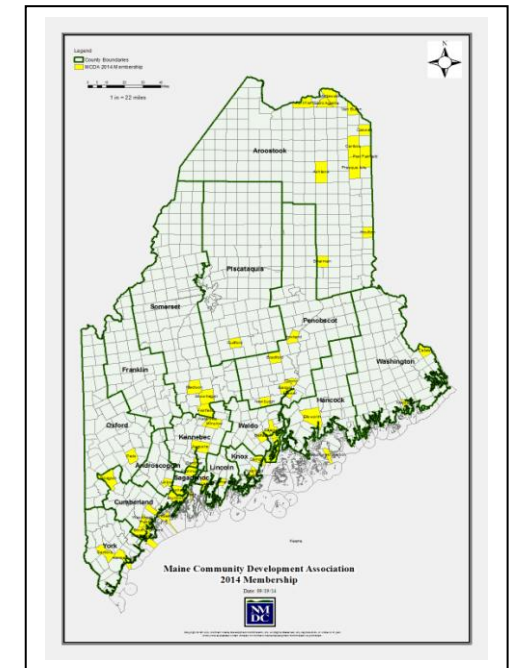
